Hello Everyone,

Well, Rachel and I just returned from our trip, mainly to the Monterey Peninsula and Lake Tahoe. We had a wonderful time. The main purpose of our trip was to attend the Monterey Car Week. As probably most of you know, Monterey Car Week is a gathering of principally sports, exotic and classic cars. The whole peninsula turns into a car show of thousands of cars. Since we were so far away from home and in Northern California we included a couple of days at Lake Tahoe also.

The Monterey Car Week includes 15 car shows, 6 major car auctions and the Monterey Historic Races. The car shows include the world famous Pebble Beach Concours d' Elegance, and the Concours Italiano. I mention Concours Italiano because I was involved in its beginnings when it was a car show for the Ferrari Owners Club, of which I was a member. This year, probably 30 or so years later, it cost \$205 to see it. Wow! Of course, that's cheap. Pebble Beach cost \$375 for General Admission. All of the high-end car auction companies had sales in Monterey that weekend. We walked through staging area for the RM Sotheby's Auction. Outside, they announced the on-going auction. While we were walking through the car display, they sold a Ferrari GTO for

\$48,400,000! Not kidding. Look it up.

We spent most of our time at the Historic Races, itself an amazing event. Over the weekend, 550 cars of all types race in 20 lap races per class. It is amazing to see, and for me and most others, to hear. There are classes ranging from early 1900's race cars to Formula 1 and everything in between. All wonderfully organized. Members, the late Al Moss, and Lon Walters have been invited to race there in the past. Rachel and I have cheered them on.

It may not be quite as awesome as Pebble Beach, but our car show will be in a couple of weeks. We will be just as proud to put it on as the Monterey car show organizers are on their shows. It's going to be a wonderful show. At our General Meeting last month I passed around, for Mike Clark, a sign-up sheet for the car show jobs. If you missed that meeting, it doesn't mean you can't (shouldn't) help at the show. Please give Mike a call and offer to help.
