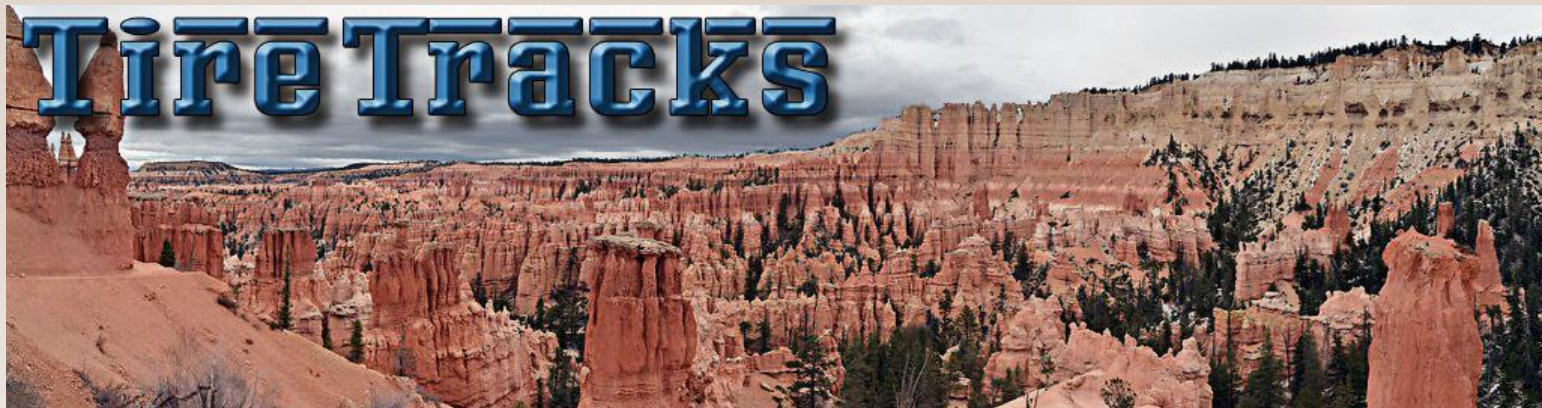

March 23, 1944 — July 9, 2019

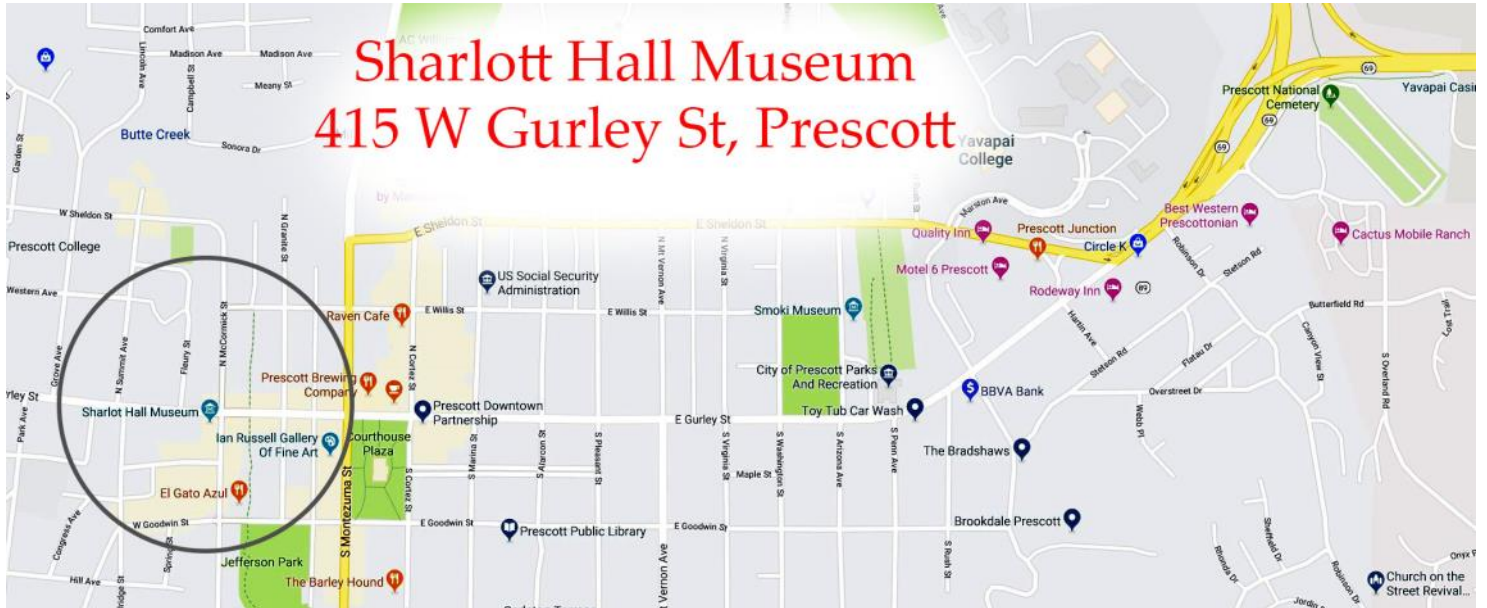
**Sharon Lee Blankenship, 75,
